In November 2014 Art2Muse Gallery was the first Australian gallery to be invited to participate in the Contemporary Istanbul Art Fair in Turkey.

We offer a home consultation service to advise on artworks. An initial visit to your home or office will include photographing the space and discussing your preferences. We will then produce a catalogue of recommended artworks superimposed on your walls as a preview before trying the pieces in your home. The \$99 consultation fee is then deducted from your first art purchase.

Peter Watts is an Australian landscape artist based in Melbourne. With more than 27 years as a creative director of his own international award-winning graphic design agency, Peter has been exposed to the arts for most of his life.

While concurrently running his graphic design studio in South Melbourne, Peter and his wife spend a lot of time at their country property in Bullarto, Victoria, where the landscape and countryside provide endless inspiration for Peter's painting practice. His latest series focuses on the dramatic cloudscapes and landscapes around Daylesford, depicting the wild combinations of shadows, movement and time shifts inherent in the high hills around central Victoria. With a distinct perspective on natural landscapes, Peter builds on his design skills to interpret and structure each painting's composition, moving from reality to subtle abstraction that brings his work to life.
